

New Haven Home Recovery and Homelessness

Homelessness at a Glance

According to the National Alliance to End Homelessness:

- There are 671,859 people experiencing homelessness on any given night in the United States- roughly 22 of every 10,000 people are homeless
- Of that number, 37% are families and 63% are individuals

There are many reasons why a person is homeless: financial crisis, substance abuse, mental illness, domestic violence. The facts and statistics below represent the amount of people facing homelessness in the nation and in Connecticut. New Haven Home Recovery is a solution, **here is NHHR's impact...**

In the past fiscal year...

- ◆ NHHR served **1,335** people throughout all 15 programs, which included **693 children**.
- ◆ NHHR helped **42% more children than last year**.
- ◆ Nationally 42% of *homeless children are under the age of 6*, similarly close to NHHR's **45%**.
- ◆ The number of people facing homelessness continues to rise, NHHR's unmet **requests have doubled** in the past year.
- ◆ NHHR **prevented 159** people from homelessness.
- ◆ NHHR ensured that **967** people were stably housed through supportive housing programs.
- ◆ The Furniture Co-op served **597 households** and **529 children**.

In the first 9 months our **Housing Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Prevention (HPRP)** program helped:

- ◆ Prevented 34 families from being homeless.
- ◆ Rapidly re-housed 19 families out of homelessness.
- ◆ Housed 6 families previously residing in motels.
- ◆ Received 500 referrals.
- ◆ Served a total of 359 households.
- ◆ Served a total of 1,142 persons.
