- Clients are referred to the Co-Op after being pre-screened by partner agencies to ensure that those truly in need are receiving the essentials.
- The Co-Op exists through the generous contributions of money, furniture, household items, clothing and time from individuals, corporations, charitable foundations and our social service agency partners.

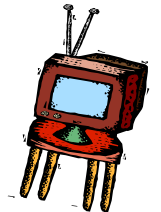
Your sofa donation may mean a child does not have to sleep on the floor;
